To Participate in a SADC TFCA Peer-to-Peer Learning Exchange Visit on Wildlife-Based Economy and Livelihoods.

The Southern African Wildlife College in collaboration with African Leadership University - School of Wildlife Conservation (ALU-SOWC) and Stellenbosch University – African Wildlife Economy Institute (AWEI) has a fully-funded opportunity for **25 candidates** involved in implementing Wildlife Based Economy and livelihoods related projects/programmes within the Southern African Development Community (SADC)'s **Transfrontier Conservation Areas (TFCAs)** to participate in a **5-day TFCA Peer-to-Peer Learning Exchange Programme within the South African component of the Great Limpopo TFCA** aimed at fostering knowledge sharing, collaboration, and best practices in **wildlife-based economies and livelihoods**.

The European Union and the German Government through the Joint Action NaturAfrica/Climate Resilience and Natural Resource Management (C-NRM) project, implemented by the **Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ)** supports this initiative, which is part of the broader Initiative to enhance Peer-to-Peer learning between TFCAs. The Southern African Wildlife College invites qualified stakeholders who meet the following requirements to express their interest in participation:

1. **Operational base:** Individuals directly working in or with SADC TFCAs and are based in the SADC region.
2. **Current engagement on Wildlife-based Economy and Livelihood activities:** Individuals managing active/ongoing project(s) focused on Wildlife-based Economy within SADC TFCAs.
3. **Alignment to individual TFCA plans or strategies:** Explanation on how the work is aligned to TFCA agreed development plans, strategies or work plans.
4. **Motivation:** Demonstrating a clear motivation to undertake the learning experience highlighting the expected benefits to project implementation in TFCAs.
5. **Travel documents:** In possession of a valid passport to travel to South Africa which is valid for at least six months from the programme start date



6. Required Documents

- 6.1 Filled in registration form (Insert Link)
- 6.2 Ideally a letter, E-mail or other proof of endorsement by a SADC TFCA Secretariat, International Coordinator or National TFCA Focal Point to endorse the individuals participation
- 6.3 Copy of the applicant's valid passport (must be valid for at least six months from the programme start date).

7. Selection Criteria:

The selection criteria will feature a broad selection in the following composition and preference:

- 7.1 **Relevance and alignment** (40%): Relevance to amplify WBE concept in TFCA and alignment to TFCA plans
- 7.2 **Motivation:** Individual motivation.
- 7.3 **Diversity and inclusion:** Representation of women, youth and SADC TFCAs geographic spread.
- 7.3 **Self-motivated to undertake training/learning experience outside their home country**, and show prior knowledge of the SADC Wildlife-based economy strategy.
- 7.4 Applicants must have **no criminal record**.

8. General Rules

- 8.1 Only application forms completed correctly, in full and accompanied by the required supporting documents will be considered.
- 8.2 Language translation will be made available should we have candidates who are not fluent in English.
