- Manages \$70m in active regional awards, across 12 countries
- Promote regional cooperation to manage transboundary natural resources



Key Focus Areas


- Biodiversity conservation & combating wildlife crime;

- Enabling environment for environmental sustainability






Current funding mechanism - River Basin Approach
